
CHAPTER LXIII.

An Ordinance Providing for the Election of a Police Judge.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St Mary, Mo., as follows:

SEC. 389. (1) That at the next City Election to be held in April, A. D. 1910, and every two years thereafter, there shall be elected a police Judge to hold his office for a term of two years, or until his successor is elected and qualified, whose compensation shall be the same as fixed by Statutes for mayor in such cases.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after



its passage.
