AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING GOLF CARTS AND UTILITY VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI.

BE IT ORDAIANED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. *Definitions:*

"CITY" The corporate limits of the City of St. Mary, Missouri.

"STREETS OR ALLEYS" Those roadways that have been accepted or platted by the City of St. Mary, Missouri as public streets and alleyways. This definition also extends to include 2nd Street and Mulberry Street (Highway 61).

"GOLF CART" A motor vehicle that is designed and manufactured for operation on a golf course for sporting or recreational purposes that is powered electrically.

"UTILITY VEHICLE" Means any motorized vehicle manufactured and used exclusively for off-highway use which is more than fifty (50) inches but no more than sixty-seven (67) inches in width, with an unladen dry weight of two thousand (2,000) pounds or less, traveling on four or six wheels, to be used primarily for landscaping, lawn care, or maintenance purposes

SECTION 2.

It shall be unlawful to operate a golf cart or utility vehicle on or in any city owned property or any city streets or alleys.

SECTION 3.

Conviction for the violation of this ordinance shall result in a fine of up to Two Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$225.00).

SECTION 4.

This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and approval.
