ORDINANCE NO. 973

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 923 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 712 ESTABLISHING OF POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DESIGNATING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Ordinance 923 amended Ordinance 712 Section 2:

SECTION 2. POLICE DEPARTMENT

The police department shall consist of the Chief of Police and such officers as the Board of Aldermen may from time to time hire. The position of Police Chief is an appointed position for a two year term or regular mayoral election unless sooner removed for cause.

By repealing Ordinance 923, Ordinance 712 Section 2 reverts back to its original language.

SECTION 2. POLICE DEPARTMENT

The police department shall consist of the Chief of Police and such officers as the Board of Aldermen may from time to time hire.
