AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SMOKING IN CITY OWNED BUILDINGS AND VEHICLES AND DESIGNATING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE TAKES EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Smoking, vaping and e-cigarettes are not allowed to be used inside city owned buildings or city owned vehicles.

SECTION 2. Violation of this ordinance by an employee or non-employee shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) and nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each and every day that the violation continues: but if the offense be willful, on conviction thereof the punishment shall be a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) for each and every day that such violation shall continue or by imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days for each and every day such violation shall continue, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

SECTION 3: Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: Effective Upon Passage.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Board of Aldermen.

SECTION 5: Incorporation into the Municipal Code.

The City Clerk shall incorporate the terms of this Ordinance into the official City of St. Mary City Code with all due dispatch.
