ORDINANCE NO. 203

AN OBDINANCE RE-ENACTING ARTICLE 2, SECTION 1, OF ORDINANCE NO. 181 OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISCOURI; PROVIDING THE TIME THEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE: AND REPEALING ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, Article 2, Section 1 of Ordinance No. 181 was heretofore repealed by implication by Ordinance No.____ and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. has since been repealed; and,

AMERIAS, it is the desire to re-enact Article 2, Section l of Ordinance wo. 181 as it originally appeared in said Ordinance No. 181.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Mary, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. That Article 2, Section 1 of Ordinance No. 181, heretofore repealed, shall be, and the same is hereby re-enacted as follows:

> "Section 1. Speed Limit. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons operating, running, or driving any motor vehicle or other vehicle to operate, run or drive the same on any highway in the City of St. Mary, Ste. Genevieve County, Missouri, at a rate of speed in excess of thirty (30) miles per hour, and it shall further be unlawful to operate, run, or drive such vehicle at intersections of highways, or when turning the corner of intersecting highways, or crossing intersecting highways, or when traversing a curve or turn in any highway, or when entering one highway from another, at a rate of speed in excess of fifteen (15) miles per hour."

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, insofar as they conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
