## ORDINANCE NO. 252.

## AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING BICYCLES

## AND ROLLER SKATING ON THE SIDEWALKS

BI IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. - Bicycles and Moller Skating Prohibited on the Sidewalks: No person shall ride, wheel, propell, or in any manner run, a bicycle upon or over the sidewalks of the City of St. Marys, nor shall any person roller skate upon or over the sidewalks of the City of St. Marys.

Section 2. - Parking Bicycles on Sidewalks Prohibited: No person shall park, leave, place or abandon any bicycle on the sidewalks of the City of St. Marys.

Section 3. - Removal of Bicycles: Whenever the City Marshal, Deputy City Marshal, Policeman, or any other City law enforcement officer shall discover any bicycles placed on the sidewalks of the City of St. Marys, he shall immediately remove said bicycle to such place as shall be designated by the City Board of Aldermen. Said bicycle shall remain in storage at said place until such time as it is redeemed by the owner thereof; and hauling and storage charges, as ascertained by the law enforcement officer removing said bicycle, shall have been paid. No bicycle is to be released to the owner thereof until such charges have been paid. In no event shall such charges exceed the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars.

person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than 500 Dollars, nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail not exceeding ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. - Conflicting Ordinances: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with this ordinance herewith are repealed and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
