AN ORDINANCE COMBINING THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM AND THE SEWERAGE SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, STE. GENEVIEVE COUNTY, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, the City of St. Mary, Ste. Genevieve County, Missouri, owns a waterworks system; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen finds that it is desirable that a sewerage system be constructed within and for said City of St. Mary and that such construction should be financed through the issuance of revenue bonds of the City to be payable from the revenues to be derived from the operation of the present waterworks system and of the sewerage system to be constructed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the present waterworks system of said City and the sewerage system to be constructed within said City be combined into one system and operated as a combined waterworks and sewerage system:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, STE. GENEVIEVE COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That, as of the first day of the month following the completion of the construction of a sewerage system within the City, the existing waterworks system of the City of St. Mary, Ste. Genevieve County, Missouri, shall be combined with the sewerage system constructed within said City into one system and that thereafter said system shall be operated as a combined waterworks and sewerage system; and said combined system shall consist of the entire waterworks system then existing and the entire sewerage system then existing of said City, together with all future improvements and extensions thereto.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and approval.
