

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE THROWING OR DEPOSITING OF LITTER, RUBBISH, OR TRASH UPON THE STREETS, SIDEWALKS OR OTHER PUBLIC PLACES OR DEPOSITING SUCH RUBBISH, TRASH OR LITTER ON PRIVATE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF ST. MARY\$, MISSOURI; PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFORE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND DESIGNATING THE TIME THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY\$, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The purpose of this ordinance, the following definition shall apply: (a) rubbish - any type of debris or rejected matter; (b) trash - worn out, used, broken up or worthless matter or material; (c) litter - scattering or dropping of trash or other matter.

SECTION 2: It shall be unlawful for any person to drive, move or propel a vehicle or to allow a vehicle owned by such person or a firm, association or a corporation to be driven, moved or propelled in such manner as to cause to be spilled, dropped or jostled onto any street, thoroughfare, highway, sidewalk or any other public place in the City, any trash or rubbish or to unload or allow a vehicle to be loaded so that the contents or any portion of the contents of such vehicle shall be spilled, dropped or jostled from any such vehicle.

SECTION 3: It shall be unlawful for any person to throw or cause to be thrown or to permit anyone in his or her employ to throw onto any public highway, thoroughfare, street, sidewalk or other public place, any rubbish, trash or litter.

SECTION 4: It shall be unlawful for any person operating a vehicle or riding in or on any vehicle to throw or cause to be thrown from such vehicle onto any public highway, thoroughfare, street, sidewalk or other public place any rubbish, trash or litter which will render such public highway, thoroughfare, street, sidewalk or other public place, unsightly, unsafe, unclean or unsanitary.

SECTION 5: The owner or person in control of any private property shall at all times maintain the premises free of litter. No person shall throw or deposit litter on any private property in the City whether owned by such person or not, provided, however, that the owner or person in control of such private property may maintain


authorized private receptacles for the deposit of rubbish, trash or litter in such a manner that the rubbish, trash or litter will be prevented from being carried, or deposited onto any public or private property.

SECTION 6: Any person, firm or association or corporation found guilty of violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the city jail not exceeding three months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 7: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
