AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE FAILURE TO HOOK UP TO THE CITY OF SAINT MARY'S SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM A NUISANCE; AUTHORIZING THE TERMINATION OF WATER SERVICE TO ABATE SUCH NUISANCES.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

SECTION TWO: Ten (10) days after notice mailed certified, return receipt requested, to the last known address of the owner of the property and the occupier of the property, the City shall immediately terminate all water service to said property.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION THREE:}}$ All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION}}\ \text{FOUR:}$ This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
