AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI TO PROVIDE MUTUAL AID OR EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE.

WHEREAS, Section 70.837 RSMo., enacted by the Missouri Legislature in 1992, now authorizes a city to permit its Department of Public Safety and Department of Public Works to provide mutual aid and emergency assistance upon request to another jurisdiction without the necessity that there be a formal signed written document for mutual aid between the City and the requesting jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- SECTION 1. MUTUAL AID AND EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE
 Under the authority set forth in Section 70.837 RSMo., the City of St. Mary Department of Public Safety, including the Police and Fire Departments, and the City of St. Mary Department of Public Works, including the Water, Sewer and Street Departments, and other City officials and employees are hereby authorized to respond and provide assistance as requested in any mutual aid or emergency aid request.
- SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage by the Board of Aldermen.
- SECTION 3. All ordinances and parts therof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.
