AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 447A AND ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR THE LOCATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF DISH ANTENNAS.

- WHEREAS, dish antennas for use in receiving television signals from satellites are becoming more poplar; and,
- WHEREAS, such dish antennas may detract from the aesthetics of the neighborhood; and,
- WHEREAS, such dish antennas must be properly located and anchored so as not to constitute a hazard to the general public.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- **SECTION 1.** A building permit is required for a dish antenna. A permit shall be issued in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance, provided that;
- A. No dish antenna over thirty-six (36) inches in diameter may be placed on a building. A dish may be attached to a building but only on the sides or on the rear of the building, not on the front side.
 - **B.** No dish antenna on a pole may exceed twenty (20) feet in height.
- C. No dish antenna may be located in a front yard. All dish antennas over thirty-six (36) inches in diameter must be located in the rear yard.
- **D.** All dish antennas must be five (5) feet from the property line. On a corner lot it cannot be closer to the side street than the main building is located.
- E. A dish antenna and its attachments are limited to one (1) dish per residence or business.
- SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.
- SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
