AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE MISSOURI HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION AND THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, ESTABLISHING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PART OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Mary, Missouri, have approved the contract between the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission and the City of St. Mary regarding Route U and related bridge improvements; and

WHEREAS, a copy of such proposed contract is attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the contract which is Exhibit "A" between the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission and the City of St. Mary, be and is hereby approved and authorized.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor of the City of St. Mary, Missouri, is hereby authorized to execute such contract on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
